DRESS CODE AND MATERIALS SUPPLY LIST

DRESS CODE

In lieu of a formal school uniform, we ask that you refrain from dressing your child for school in clothing that promote media characters, i.e. Disney, video games, television shows and movies. We find that these create distraction, aggression, violence and escape from reality.

We also ask that you do not send accessories, lunch boxes, water bottles, etc. with these images on them. No jewelry, real or play. Except for objects for the Letter of the Week Basket each week, toys are not acceptable.

Please dress your child in play clothes, socks and sneakers. Clothing should be loose and comfortable. No belts please. Your child should not require assistance to undress or dress, especially when toileting. Your child should be able to take off and put on his/her shoes with little assistance. Please do not send your child to school in tie up shoes unless you are working on shoe tying at home. Closed toe shoes are required for the playground.

Hair should be secured away from child's face to prevent visual obstructions and distractions. Please include hair clips and hair ties in your child's personal belongings along with a brush or comb.

MATERIAL SUPPLY LIST

The following items are for health, hygiene and educational reasons. We request that the following items be brought and left at school.

School Supplies for Newly Enrolled Students: PLEASE LABEL WITH CHILD'S NAME 1 spiral bound sketchbook , at least 8 1/2 x 11"

Newly Enrolled Students: DO NOT LABEL 4 x 6 " framed family picture

Personal Items: PLEASE LABEL WITH CHILD'S NAME and place in a Ziplock bag Hair brush or comb (hair clips and hair ties as needed)
Shirt (seasonal)
Pants (seasonal) [multiple if your child is new to toileting]
Underwear (multiple pairs for children who are new to toileting) socks
Soft-soled indoor shoes

The school has a very limited supply of "extra" clothing items. If your child is sent home in these clothes, please launder and return them the next school day.

Nap Bedding: PLEASE LABEL BEDDING AND THE BAG IT IS SENT IN Nap sack (napper) or blanket, towel, etc. NO SLEEPING BAGS PLEASE. Your child should be able to put these items away independently.

Nap bedding will be sent home each week for laundering. Please be sure to send it back to school the next school day. The school has very limited "extra" bedding.

Requests for supplies will be made during the year when necessary.
